Each of the five suites is named after and decorated to represent some of Selena's favorite southern towns: Seaside, FL Suite in beautiful hues of blue and soft greens and decorated with seashells; Natchez, MS Suite in French decor, complete with an elegant crystal chandelier; Charlottesville, VA Suite is the grandest of the rooms with a beautiful hand-carved four-post bed, in-room fireplace and a free-standing air-jet soaking tub; Beaufort, SC Suite in low country flavor is designed to accommodate two additional guests in twin fold-out window seat beds; and, Madison, GA Suite with peaceful shades of blue and a window seat with a million-dollar view.

"Owning a bed and breakfast has been a longtime dream for me," said Selena Einwechter, owner of Bed and Breakfast on Tiffany Hill. "I am ecstatic to open this gorgeous, new inn offering highly personalized service to my guests. In addition to the main guest house, four acres of the property was developed into flourishing gardens. The trail offers natural beauty with developed garden spots and little surprises along the way.
